- **Full registration and at least half room and board payment due by March 15, 2025. Full payment is due to the registrars by May 15, 2025.**
- Day visitors must give **advance notice** before arrival. They will pay Winni a \$20 per day registration fee. **Payment to GPC for day use and meals must be made directly at the GPC office.**
- There is no charge for children under age 3. Guests must bring their own crib.
- We are unable to reduce rates or give refunds if you arrive later or depart earlier than your registration indicates.

CHILDREN AND YOUTH
